

WORLD **NO** TOBACCO DAY



Tobacco **KILLS** about **6 MILLION** per year of which **600,000** are non-smokers dying from second-hand smoke. Without action, in 2030

8 MILLION will DIE. Of these preventable deaths,

80% are among people living in low- and middle income countries



Tobacco is a **GRADUAL** killer but someone dies every **6 SECONDS** equaling 1 in 10 adult deaths

Leading cause of DEATH ILLNESS IMPOVRISHMENT

Adults: **serious** cardiovascular and respiratory diseases **coronary heart disease AND lung cancer**



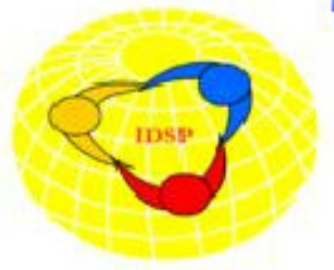
Children: **28%** of deaths from smoke **40%** of kids have one smoking parent **50%** of children breathe polluted tobacco-smoke air
